### How to get to Karasabai:

Karasabai can be reached by one of four daily flights from Georgetown to Lethem, followed by a once daily three-hour bus ride or a special four by four charter from Lethem to Karasabai Village.

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**Mission and Vision:** Our mission is to promote eco-tourism in Karasabai. We seek to promote the home of the sun parakeet as a tourist destination and to educate local communities and stakeholders to operate in an environmentally friendly way that always respects local ecosystems. Our vision is to help marginalized people and endangered parrots living in this vulnerable area through tourism and to promote conservation through responsible tourism activities.

**Birdwatching:** Karasabai is well known by serious birders for being the only location in Guyana where the sun parakeet, also known locally as “flying jewels,” can be found.

**Village Tours:** Cultural and heritage enthusiasts can tour local cassava farms and witness farine production. Visitors can also tour sacred village sites.

**History of Karasabai:** Karasabai is ideally located, south of the magnificent Pakaraimas Mountain range. It is home to the Macushi people. Karasabai derives its name from two Machushi words: “Krasa,” which means “old canister” and “Ebai,” which means “a deep pool of water.” This canister was found in the north-east of one of the many surrounding beautiful mountains. Karasabai is an exciting, emerging destination for community-based tourism, with its combination of opportunities to enjoy nature, culture, heritage and adventure.
